

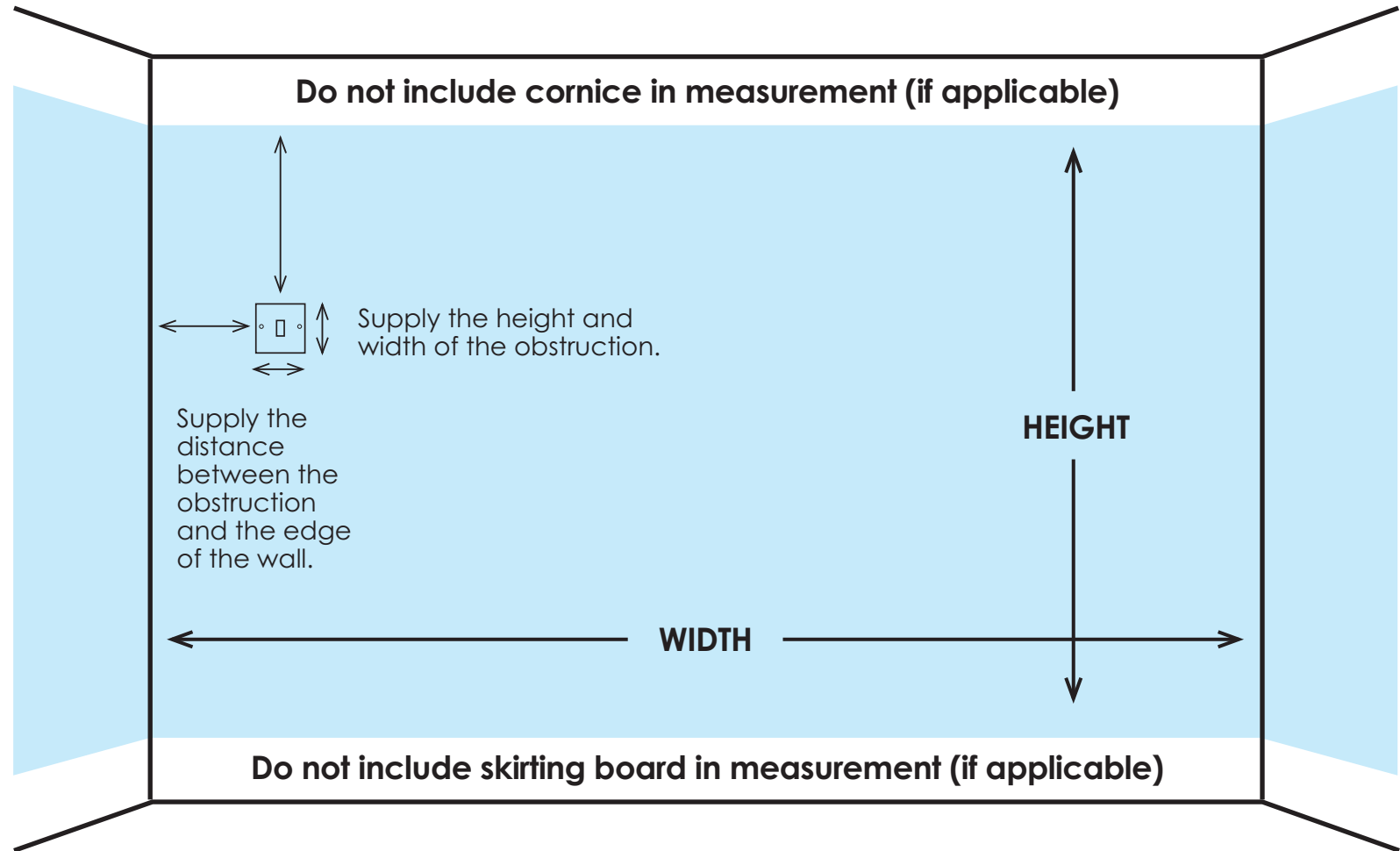
Wall Mural Measurement Guide

If you're ready for us to get started on your wall mural design, we will need you to provide us with accurate measurements of the wall being papered, along with any obstructions that may affect the design.

These obstructions may include:

- Door Frames
- Windows
- Light Switches
- Plug Sockets
- Wall Vents
- Radiators

And any other permanent fixtures that would need to be cut around to paper the wall.



A few points to remember:

- When measuring around doors and windows, please ensure you measure from the outside of the frame to the edge of the wall
- We are unable to offer a fitting service at this time. However, for best results we do suggest arranging a handy man or decorator to fit the wallpaper.
- Wallpaper or vinyl will be supplied for the whole wall you wish to paper regardless of obstructions. Any obstructions will need to be cut out by the decorator when the wallpaper is being applied.
- Will things be hung on the wall once the wallpaper has been applied? If so, think about where these will be going and advise us so we can accommodate for this in your design.
- Have a think about where the wallpaper is going and the best paper option for that room. e.g Care Home dining rooms may wish to use self-adhesive vinyl rather than a textured paper as it can be easier to clean and keep hygienic.
